

PARSHA QUESTION OF THE WEEK

YOSEF & THE PITS

When Yosef first falls into the hands of his brothers, he is thrown into a pit, only to be pulled from the pit to quickly rise to great prominence as the master of Potiphar's house. Then he is again thrown into a pit, i.e. the jail of Egypt which the Torah identifies as a pit (see 41:14), from where he arises again to great prominence, this time as the viceroy of Egypt. There seems to be a repetition of Yosef's cycle of tragedy and deliverance. Indeed, when the brothers originally brought Yaakov the bloodied cloak of Yosef, Yaakov exclaimed that a wild animal must have eaten Yosef. Rashi there (37:33) cites the Midrash that these words would prove prophetic, as the wife of Potiphar is referred to as a bear (see Rashi 38:6) - a wild animal - and she would indeed attempt to destroy Yosef. She - like the brothers - removes his outer shirt before he is again thrown into the pit. The cycle is thus repeated completely. Why does it have to be repeated? While we understand that Yosef may have done something to deserve some punishment (Rashi 38:6), why does it seem that it is the very same punishment as for his original missteps, indeed bringing him right back to where he started? Isn't once enough?

HALACHA OF THE WEEK: A FEATURE OF THE BISZ DAILY HALACHA SHIUR

LECHEM MISHNEH

The two main meals of Shabbos must include bread, while the third meal should ideally include it. Whenever one has bread at a meal on Shabbos – even if he were to have four or five meals – he should always make *Motzi* on two whole loaves or rolls, *Lechem Mishneh*, to recall the miracle of the double portion of *Mannah* that would arrive from the heavens for the sake of Shabbos (OC 274:1; 291:4). Nevertheless if one did not have two whole loaves or rolls, only pieces of bread, he should still wash and make the *Motzi* so as to fulfill the *Mitzvah* of feasting properly on Shabbos (MB 274:2; 291:20). When making the *Motzi*, the Shulchan Aruch cites the proper custom – based on Kabbalistic sources – that on Friday night we break the lower *Challah* first, while at all other meals of Shabbos and Yom Tov we break the upper *Challah* first (OC 274:1).
