The Weekly Parsha



Sedrah Selections – Selections

Ch. 41, v. 1: "Choleim" — Is dreaming — Shouldn't the verse have said "cholam," he dreamt? This indicates that he dreamt the same dream continuously for two years. He did not enlist only the services of Yoseif to divine the dream. For two whole years he had many people explain the dream, but none to his satisfaction. (This explains "kol chartumei Mitzrayim" of verse 8.) With a slight variation: Every morning for two years he forgot his dream. At exactly two years of dreaming the same dream he finally remembered his dream, and Yoseif was called to divine it. (Medrash Hagodol)

This dream was continually replayed all night long, hence the present tense. (Rabbeinu Menachem)

Ch. 41, v. 1: "U'Faroh choleim" — The word "choleim" is spelled defectively, lacking the letter Vov between the Ches and the Lamed. We are thus left with the letters Ches-Lamed-Mem. These letters can be switched around to form the words "ChoMeiL" and "LeCHeM." Inherent in Paroh's dream was that Hashem sent a message of mercy, "chemloh," that during the years of abundance, sustenance, "lechem," should be set aside.

Ch. 41, v. 3, 4: "Olose acha'rei'hen ... vataamode'noh eitzel, Vatochalnoh" — The seven emaciated cows represent the evil inclination. They first rise against a person, "olose," then stand right next to him, "vataamode'noh eitzel," and then finally overpower and swallow him, "vatochalnoh." (Sfas Emes)

Ch. 41, v. 45: "Tzofnas Paa'nei'ach" — Hidden clarified — The sale of Yoseif was hidden from all, save those who participated and the purchasers. There was one exception, our Patriarch Yitzchok (Rashi on 37:35 d.h. "va'yeivk"). To all it was hidden, save Yitzchok, whose name has the same numerical value as "paa'nei'ach," clarified. (Nirreh li)

Ch. 42, v. 16: "M'raglim a'tem" — You are spies — Yoseif knew that they weren't spies, so how did he allow an outright lie to escape his lips? He used the word "m'raglim" as an acronym for "Mi'zera Rochel G'navtem L'orchas Yish'm'eilim M'chartem." (Sheivet Musor)

In verse 11 Yoseif's brothers said, "Lo HOYU avo'decho m'raglim." This unusual expression, in the past tense, alluded to their saying that in the past they were not spies, but in the future they would be. This is because

their souls would enter the bodies of the tribal heads in the desert who were sent to spy out Canaan. This could also explain Yoseif's claiming that they are spies. (n.l.)

Ch. 43, v. 34: "Va'yishtu va'yish'k'ru imo"

— And they drank and they became inebriated with him — The brothers had not consumed any wine from the time they sold Yoseif. Why did they break away from this behaviour now? Yoseif accused them of being spies. If they would not be afraid to become drunk, which carries with it the risk of letting out all one's secrets, "nichnas yayin yotzo sode" (gemara Eiruvin 65a), this would be solid proof that they were innocent. (Zichron Moshe)

Ch. 44, v. 4: "Lo hirchiku" — They didn't go far — Yoseif sent after them immediately, so that they would not have said "t'filas ha'derech." Once they would have said "t'filas ha'derech," which includes the words "mikaf ko oyeiv ... umikol mi'nei furonios," the messenger would have been unable to catch them and cause any stress through the trumped up charges, so great is the power of this prayer. (Imrei Emes)
