Roya Hakakian -- award-winning author and Jewish native of Iran -- will speak and sign copies of her books at Kesher at 7:30 PM on Sunday, January 22, 2012. Her highly regarded book, Journey from the Land of No: A Girlhood Caught in Revolutionary Iran, is a memoir of growing up as a Jewish teenager in post-revolutionary Iran. After receiving a Guggenheim Fellowship, she just published Assassins of the Turquoise Palace, detailing an amazing but little-known story of Iran's terror campaign and trial in Western Europe. Ms. Hakakian, a Whitney Humanities Fellow at Yale University and a founding member of the Iran Human Rights Documentation Center, speaks frequently throughout the US and Europe. Her opinion columns, essays, and book reviews have appeared in The New York Times, The Washington Post, and The Wall Street Journal, and she is a contributor to NPR's All Things Considered.
