URGENT COMMUNITY MESSAGE

Hatzalah has established a command center on the scene of the partial building collapse in Surfside as well as at the Family Reunification Center at the Surfside Community Center located at 93rd and Collins Ave. Anyone affected by the incident or looking for a loved one should make their way to the Family Reunification Center. Efforts are being coordinated there with multiple agencies to provide displaced residents with food, shelter, medical care and more.

There are still many people unaccounted for and search and rescue efforts are underway. A hotline has been set up for anyone concerned about the whereabouts of a loved one. The number is 847-322-1422. Please do not call the Hatzalah emergency hotline for information.

The Shul of Bal Harbour and Young Israel of Bal Harbour have set up collection points for the following items for displaced residents:

- Advil / Tylenol
- Sweatshirts
- Phone chargers
- Drinks (water / powerade)
- Blankets / sheets
- Pillows
- Snacks
- Fruit
- Games
